College Prep English 11

College prep students will read The Great Gatsby and The Old Man and the Sea.

Students must read the books taking chapter notes in preparation for an examination on each book during the month of September. Notes should include information on major themes, important characters and settings, and critical events that help support the plot and themes. Notes will be checked and used in class.

Honors English 11

Students must read the above books and complete the note-taking. In addition, Honors students must read To Kill a Mockingbird using the same assigned format for preparation for an exam in September.

All three books are American classics and each is written at or above grade level 11. We encourage students to begin the readings early in the summer to assure completion. And, most important, we want all students to appreciate the literature and the creative stories invented by three unique American authors.
