



2020-2021 Student Attendance Guidelines & Expectations

Remote Days (Remote only students and hybrid students): Students are expected to follow the bell schedule and log in to each of their classes throughout the school day using the Google Classroom/Google Meets platform.

During remote instruction, students are expected to do their best to participate from a location that is free from distraction and follow teachers' directions regarding when to interact through the Google Meeting and when to log off and work independently.

If a student experiences technical issues that prevent him/her from accessing the Google Classroom/Google Meet, they should communicate with their teacher(s) via email or telephone and attempt to get their assignments through another mode. This communication will allow the teacher to consider the student present for class.

In-person Days (Hybrid students only): If a student is not physically present in the building, they will be marked absent. Students are still encouraged to participate in their classes remotely if they are able. If the student's absence is for medical reasons or other reasons that would otherwise excuse their absence per board policy, please submit documentation to the main office.
