**Safety on the Slopes – Snowboard/Ski Safely!** We strongly encourage first-timers to take a lesson. If you are scheduled for a lesson, go directly to the lesson before riding. Remember that the person in front of you has the right of way.

**Helmets and Wrist Guards:** We strongly encourage you to wear a snowboard/ski helmet. For snowboarders, we also encourage you to wear wrist guards. Wrist guards can greatly reduce the risk of wrist injuries for snowboarders. SBYS has a limited number of wrist guards available to borrow for the day. Please contact us to reserve a wrist guard.

**Comfort (dress to stay warm and dry):** Wear snowboard/ski pants or other waterproof clothing. Don't forget gloves, hat, goggles, or sunglasses and an extra pair of dry socks. Let us know ahead of time if you would like to borrow a pair of snow pants.

**Food:** We do not have a scheduled stop on the way to the slopes. You may bring food to eat on the bus, and outside food is permitted in the lodge. Food on the mountain is expensive; therefore, we encourage you to pack at least some of your food or snacks. Students will also need to pack food or bring enough money to buy something to eat at our fast-food stop on the way home.

**Day of the trip:**

**5:15 am:** Meet at CMCTHS parking lot at **5:15 am** so you will have time to load your gear on the bus and find a seat. Set two alarm clocks and make sure you have arranged for a ride. If the trip is rescheduled due to extreme weather conditions you will be contacted by text reminder (see below - Remind 101)

**5:30 am:** The bus will leave CMCTHS parking lot at **5:30 am sharp!**

**9:00 am:** The bus will arrive at Jack Frost at approximately **9:00 am**. When we arrive, please remain seated until your name is called at which time you will receive your lift ticket and any rental ticket or lesson ticket you may need. You may then proceed to the rental shop to pick up your equipment and then to the lesson area if you are taking a lesson. If this is the first time snowboarding/skiing or you are unsure of your ability we strongly recommend taking a lesson.

**4:00 pm:** Please return your equipment to the rental shop and head back to the bus by **4:15 pm**. Please do not be late!

**4:30 pm:** The bus will leave Jack Frost by **4:30 pm**. We will stop for food on the way home.

**8:30 pm:** The bus will return to CMCTHS parking lot approximately at **8:30 pm**. Please make arrangements to have someone pick you up.
