Institutional Scholarships

Search the colleges' web sites for links to scholarship opportunities that apply when you are accepted. Each college lists its criteria for renewable freshman scholarships on its web site. Be sure to apply by the Scholarship Consideration Deadline, not the Regular Admission Deadline

FAFSA

- A student may submit his or her FAFSA data after October 1, 2018. Begin with your parent/guardian by creating an FSA ID. The Guidance webpage has a Power Point presentation on documents needed, the FAFSA process, and has some helpful tips on affording college.
- Placing a New Jersey Public University first in the choice of colleges or technical schools the student lists to receive the report will qualify you to be considered for state aid in addition to federal aid.
- Keep in mind that merit and local scholarships often require filing a FAFSA.

SAT

Cape May County Technical High School's school code (CEEB Code) is 310207

Be sure to indicate the school code on your SAT registration so that your scores will be reported to the guidance department and included on your transcript.
